COVID-19 Response (December 2021)

- If you are sick, please stay home and join us online for worship ([Hillside LiveStream](#)). We will continue to stream the service online for as long as we need to.

Also, if you are sick, please do a "health check," and if you have a fever (above 38°C), chills, cough, difficulty breathing, or loss of sense of smell or taste, contact a health care provider or call 8-1-1 about your symptoms or next steps

- **Mask rules have changed as of December 1, 2021.** Masks are now required to be worn during the worship service except when eating or drinking (i.e., Lord's Supper).
- Also, we are limited to 50% of our seated capacity in the sanctuary which is about 220 people (including balcony and floor). This means we can have 110 people in the sanctuary at any one time for worship. If necessary, the Elders have agreed to add another service (to increase capacity) instead of ever checking vaccine status for worship services.
- We encourage you to do your part to help slow the transmission of COVID-19 everywhere.
